Flathead Basin Rule for AIS Watercraft Inspection

Any watercraft that's been used on waters outside the Flathead Basin must be inspected at an FWP inspection station prior to launching in the Flathead Basin

Flathead Basin Rule: Vessels and equipment traveling into the Flathead Basin that have been used on waters outside of the Flathead Basin must be inspected at a watercraft inspection station prior to launching within the Flathead Basin. ARM Rule 12.5.709

Please note this list does NOT include ALL the lakes inside or outside of the Flathead Basin. Aquatic invasive species are listed if known.
