#### 2:00 Quick Tips to Paddle Faster

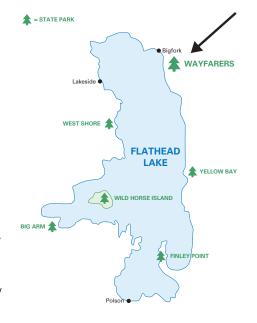
The Flathead Paddlers will start on land to guide you through how to efficiently and effectively paddle. Once through some basics, you'll put your knowledge to the test on the water!

Teams should consist of two people and all participants must be over the age of 12, and must wear a lifejacket.
