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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report summarizes weed management expenditures and accomplishments across all three divisions of Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks (FWP) during Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20), which includes July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

FWP directly manages 511,090 acres across 496 distinct sites throughout the state and is responsible for noxious weed management on most of these areas. Estimated infested acres for all FWP lands for FY20 were 56,334, equaling approximately 11% infested. The acreages associated within each separate Division are as follows:

- The Fisheries Division manages approximately 17,196 acres in fee title and leased lands across 354 sites, primarily Fishing Access Sites (FAS's). Estimated noxious weed infested acres for FWP lands managed by the Fisheries Division were 2,749, equaling approximately 16% infested in FY20. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 931 acres, equaling approximately 34% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.
- The Wildlife Division manages approximately 451,313 acres in fee title and leased lands across 79 sites, primarily as Wildlife Management Area (WMA) lands. Estimated noxious weed infested acres for FWP lands managed by the Wildlife Division were 48,655, equaling approximately 11% infested in FY20. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 6,783 acres, equaling approximately 14% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.
- The Parks Division manages approximately 42,470 acres in fee title and leased lands across 58 sites, primarily as State Parks (SP). Estimated noxious weed infested acres for FWP lands managed by the Parks Division were 4,904, equaling approximately 12% infested in FY20. Utilizing chemical, mechanical, biological control and revegetation treatment methods the division treated 3,262 acres, equaling approximately 67% of infested acres treated for the fiscal year.

FWP continues to implement an integrated approach to controlling noxious weeds, as further described in FWP's statewide noxious weed plan (2008). That plan can be accessed and downloaded using the following web link:

Using an integrated approach to managing weeds, FWP staff prioritize efforts and select the most appropriate technique for addressing each noxious weed issue. For instance, infestations with a high likelihood of spreading to new locations are a priority for herbicide treatment, including parking lots, roads, and other high public use areas. New infestations in areas that previously lacked infestations or new noxious weed species are also a high priority for treatment and eradication, if possible. Vast infestations often require a different approach in collaboration with neighboring properties and county weed coordinators. Biocontrol in combination with herbicide applications at strategic locations are commonly used as a long-term solution where infestations are extensive, spanning multiple ownerships.

FWP also strives to take an ecological approach to weed management and prevention. This includes, where possible, avoiding ground disturbance, minimizing impacts from construction or other management activities, and being mindful to avoid impacting non-target vegetation when implementing weed control measures.

During FY2020 FWP treated over 7,030 acres with herbicides, an increase of approximately 1,036 acres from the previous fiscal year equaling about 12% of reported estimated infested acres (Table 2) for the year. Combined with other types of treatments – mechanical and insect/biocontrol, the department treated approximately 10,975 acres and grazed 20,610 acres with expenditures being an estimated total of \$399,218.36 on weed management (Table 3). Some personnel costs, training, education and outreach, and other aspects of weed management and prevention are not included in these figures.

In addition to work on FWP lands, the department also provides funding toward weed management on private lands through the Block Management Program (Table 1). In 2020, FWP paid over \$ 288,985 to private landowners specifically to weed control.

FWP works closely with other government agencies including Department of Natural Resources and Conservation, U.S. Forest Service, MT Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Land Management and County Weed Coordinators along with private contractors and private landowners, to coordinate weed control efforts and to help contain the spread of noxious weeds throughout the state.

FWP also strives to utilize other collaborative efforts for weed control with public service programs such as AmeriCorps and the Montana Conservation Corps. Through these efforts, Montana State Parks AmeriCorps (MSPA) members were responsible for 550 hours of service pertaining to weeds on FWP-managed properties. Duties within those hours included noxious weed management tasks such as recruiting volunteers for and conducting hand pulling weeds, biological control releases, and herbicide treatments which resulted in 134 acres of weeds treated in addition to conducting vegetation monitoring of known infested sites.

Fiscal Year 2020 saw the third round of applications for the Wildlife Habitat Improvement Program (WHIP) administered by FWP. WHIP was passed into law with the purpose of restoring ecologically important wildlife habitats by managing noxious weeds at watershed or landscape scales, typically involving collaborative efforts over multiple landownerships. The Act makes available up to \$2M annually in federal Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration (P-R) funds. In FY20 the WHIP Advisory Council voted to fund four submitted grants totaling \$1,161,987. These projects started receiving WHIP funding on August 1st, 2020:

- **Elkhorn Wildlife Management Area WHIP Project – 5 Year project**
 - 152,000 acres of priority wildlife habitat
 - 8,290 acres receiving herbicide treatments, biological controls, and reseeding

- \$316,825 – Grant Funds PR dollars); \$105,608 Matching Funds; Total Project: \$422,433
- **Blacktail WHIP Project – 5 Year Project**
 - 155,351 acres of priority wildlife habitat
 - 1,874 acres receiving herbicide treatment
 - \$155,000 Grant Funds (PR dollars); \$69,647 Matching Funds; Total Project: \$224,647




Figure 1. Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks Administrative Regional Boundaries

The Data Tables Section of this report, which follows, summarizes weed infestation and control activities over most of the sites managed by FWP. This data is collected annually from the staff responsible for managing these sites. Data are organized by Administrative Region (Figure 1) and then by Division and County.
