Bird Checklist



Mount Haggin WMA encompasses 58,188 acres with an elevation of 6,467 feet. It is located in Deer Lodge and Silver Bow Counties, approximately 10 miles south of Anaconda at the base of the Anaconda-Pintlar Mountains. Highway access is along MT Highway 569. Open May 15-Nov 30 west of the Continental Divide and yearround east of the divide.

Fleccer Mountain WMA encompasses 7,394 with an elevation of 5,642. It is located in Silver Bow county 10 miles south of Butte off I-15, Take the Divide exit, MT Highway 43. Open May 15-Nov 30.
