

Elk and Deer – HD 150



Draft Changes for 2022-2023 Hunting Regulations (boundary types, LPT changes, species, etc.):

Boundary Change: Combine Hunting District 150 and HD 280. The new combined district would be identified as HD 150 and would adopt the current HD 150 regulations.

Biological Implications:

Boundary Change: No biological concern. Elk and deer in this area are largely migratory.

Social Implications:

Regulations in both districts are similar for elk and deer. This would simplify the regulations by reducing the number of hunting districts. There would be some loss of antlerless elk hunting opportunity in the archery and youth seasons as well as antlerless white-tailed deer opportunity.
