

# Moose – HD 360



## **Draft Changes for 2022-2023 Hunting Regulations:**

Combine districts: Combine moose Hunting Districts 309, 360 and portions of HD 308 into one new district, HD 360. This would make boundaries the same as the proposed deer/elk HD 360. This would include a small portion of the proposed moose HD 311 (current moose HD 313) near McAllister being placed into moose HD 360 for common boundaries with deer/elk districts.

Moose HD 308 would be dissolved, and portions would go into moose HDs 310, 311 and 360, following deer/elk HD boundaries.

The total number of licenses issued would be four.

## **Biological Implications:**

The boundary changes follow regulation simplicity directives, promoting regulation simplicity and the concepts of larger hunting districts with similar boundaries between species.

Currently, three moose licenses are offered in HD 309, but success rates were poor the last two years, indicating a reduction in license opportunity is merited.

Currently, three moose licenses are valid in the combination of HDs 308, 313 and 360. With this proposed change, the new moose HD 311 (current moose HD 313) would become a standalone district. It will retain two licenses.
