Giant Springs is the most visited State Park in Montana and our primary obligation is to ensure that all the visitors have a quality experience while at the park. This means that events, such as weddings, are more heavily regulated to ensure that they don't negatively impact park visitors. Also, remember that even if you reserve a portion of the park, the trails, viewing areas and other group-use sites remain open to the public. Please keep this information in mind while you read this document and plan your wedding.

Group-Use Expectations

- Between the Friday before Mother's Day and the 3rd Saturday in September, no wedding parties of 31 or more will be hosted in Central Picnic Area and will be referred to Heritage Picnic Area.
- Weddings with more than 150 people will not be allowed at either site.
- Ceremonies and receptions will not be allowed next to the Giant Springs or Roe River. That includes the viewing platforms and Roe Island.
- Ceremonies and receptions must stay near the reserved site.
- Photos are allowed near the Giant Springs *See permit requirements*
- Wedding parties of 31 or more must have a valid Special Use permit with Montana State Parks.
- Wedding photographers or videographers must have a valid Commercial Use Permit from Montana State Parks to shoot or film in the park.
- No balloons, piñatas, confetti, rice or silly string are allowed. Bird seed is allowed.
- Directional signs not allowed on roadways.
- Decorations are allowed on picnic tables and shelters, but not trees.
- Generators are allowed in Heritage Picnic Area only.
- Acoustical music is permitted. No amplified music is allowed at either site.
- Tents and canopies are allowed with approval only. Park staff must help with set up to ensure our sprinkler lines are not hit by the stakes.
- The site must be left as is or in better condition than you found it.
- We do not provide chairs, running water, power, catering or indoor space. All garbage must be placed in the designated bins. Park staff is not responsible for cleaning up after your event.

Pricing

Groups 30 or Less : \$100 + \$25 Reservation Fee
Groups 31 - 50 : \$150 + \$25 Reservation Fee (Referred to Heritage)
Groups 51 or More : \$200 + \$25 Reservation Fee (Heritage Only)

How to Reserve

- Visit the Montana State Park reservation site at stateparks.mt.gov
- Find *Reserve a Campsite or Park Facility*
- Search and select Giant Springs State Park
- Click *Book Now* and our 2 sites will appear
- Enter a date to check availability
- Click *Book These Dates* to reserve
- You will then be prompted to create a profile to finish your reservation and to make a payment
- Reservations can be made up to 9 months in advance.
