Create a reasonable smooth surface free of loose rock, clods, holes, projections, depressions, and muddy conditions.

- Fill materials: recycled ground asphalt mixed with pea size gravel packed and leveled
- Pack the underlayment a minimum of 2 passes, using wheeled excavation equipment/manually directed power tampers/other approved method.
