OBJECTIVES AND DEGREE OF ATTAINMENT

- 1. To interview as many anglers as possible at the established creel census station. Interviews were begun at the beginning of the general fishing season the 3rd Saturday in May and will continue until close to the end of the general season November 30, 1993. To date about 2,650 anglers have been interviewed. The data will be analyzed and reported in next years' report.
- To interview anglers on approximately one-half the week days, one-half the weekends, and all major holidays. This goal will be accomplished by the end of the project.
- 3. To enter census data on department computer, provide periodic updates as the season progresses and a final report at the end of the fishing season. This goal has been accomplished.
