ABSTRACT

During the report period, 317 Notice of Construction applications were received and reviewed. Measures were requested to reduce or mitigate damage to streams and fish habitat.

Fish and wildlife information for environmental assessments was provided to the State Department of Transportation on request. Environmental impact assessments submitted for all state highway projects were reviewed and commented on as required.

Regional fisheries personnel reviewed 915 project applications for 310 permits. Team inspections were conducted on 68% of these. Two river mechanics training workshops were presented and attended by about 100 participants.

An engineering consultation services firm has been contracted to assist with hydraulic problems on projects that require special consideration.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To coordinate administration of the Stream Protection Act (SPA) and the Natural Streambed and Land Preservation Act (310) to ensure the preservation of Montana streams in their natural, existing state.
- 2. To provide recommendations as provided by Sec. 404 of the Clean Water Act to avoid impacts to wetlands contiguous to streams or in project corridors.
- To assist with interagency coordination with other state and federal agencies, agricultural, corporate and other private entities in an effort to promote stream habitat management.

Objective 3 was accomplished with state funding.

PROCEDURES

State, county, municipal and political subdivisions are required to provide SPA notices to the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks (DFWP) at least 60 days prior to construction for projects which may affect stream beds or stream banks. Irrigation district projects and emergencies are exempt from the act.

The Department provides notification forms to applicants for completion and return to the department. Plans are reviewed by Helena and regional staff to determine if any adverse impacts to fish or wildlife will occur. Recommendations are made to the applicant to eliminate or reduce any adverse impacts. The act provides for an arbitration procedure if a discrepancy arises and an agreement cannot be reached.

The regions continue to process SPA applications from miscellaneous and county categories. The Helena office will continue to process all Department of Transportation sponsored applications and keep a central file on all issued permits and transactions.

A Memorandum of Understanding with the Montana Department of Health and Environmental Sciences provide that we screen construction projects for the potential exceedence of the water quality standard for turbidity, and then so advise that agency. Other state agencies cooperate to varying degrees under informal agreements.

Several federal agencies have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department. Although federal compliance with the Act has been inconsistent, the Forest Service has made an excellent effort to comply with the SPA with a lesser effort by other agencies. The Department will make an attempt to meet with the federal agencies to renew and update the existing MOU.

A private individual, corporation, firm, partnership, association, or other legal entity not covered under the Stream Protection Act must, before altering or modifying the bed or banks of stream, obtain a 310 permit from the local Conservation District Board of Supervisors. Fisheries personnel are required as part of the permitting process to review plans and make recommendations for reducing or eliminating impacts to the streambed or banks and thereby protect fish habitat. The permitting process normally includes on-site inspections and takes less than 60 days to process. If a dispute occurs, there is a provision for arbitration or further litigation.

The project leader will maintain guidelines to provide consistent statewide approach to administration and recommendations for 310 projects. Division activities will be coordinated on all arbitration proceedings dealing with disagreements and violations. Technical assistance will be provided to fisheries personnel when unusual, difficult or hard to solve hydrologic problems occur.

Training will be provided for new fisheries biologists assigned to stream protection duties.

Approximately 80% of job time will be utilized on cold water streams and 20% on warm or cool water streams.

Fish population data are usually available from the department's Fisheries Division, and are supplied by regional offices. When adequate data are not available, requests are made to the appropriate region to obtain such data.

Engineering consultation service will be obtained under a contract with a private hydrologist for engineering expertise.

FINDINGS

Stream Protection Act

A total of 317 Notice of Construction applications were reviewed and processed during this report period. Of these notices, 50 were for state highway projects (Table 1), 57 for county road and bridge projects (Table 2), and 210 for miscellaneous projects (Table 3). Miscellaneous projects included projects by federal agencies, municipalities, and state agencies other than the Department of Transportation (DOT).

The Department will renew the Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) it has with several state and federal agencies which established and implemented the operating procedures for identification, evaluation and mitigation of highway construction impacts to wetlands. This MOU allows the state to comply with Federal requirements of Section 404 and allows a positive approach for wetland mitigation.

A wetland technical subcommittee carries out the functions of the program under direction of the Interagency Wetlands Group. The Interagency Wetlands group is represented by personnel from the Environmental Protection Agency, Fish and Wildlife Service, Federal Highway Administration, Department of Transportation, Department of Health and Environmental Sciences and the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks. Cooperation shown by the agencies involved indicate success of the program.

Recommendations to protect streams and wetlands were generally well received. To reduce adverse effects on streams and rivers, we will continue our awareness program of stream and water quality protection for agencies and general contractors. Some projects are of a nature that they can be handled in a routine manner. Other projects require several meetings for coordination and detailed investigation to resolve issues.

Periodically, the Department experiences a lack of cooperation from DOT and a project contractor in fulfilling the conditions set forth in the SPA and MOU. In order to rectify the situation, the Department, in conjunction with DOT is currently redrafting the existing MOU to reflect changes that are necessary to reduce the number of SPA violations and bring a project into compliance with the SPA requirements and stipulations.

An educational program directed toward DOT personnel was developed and presented to their headquarter's personnel and 3 DOT districts. These workshops were conducted during the winter. The objectives of the workshops were to inform DOT personnel of the values and importance fish and wildlife habitat and the need to reduce all unnecessary adverse impacts to the state's rivers and streams from road construction activities.

Natural Streambed and Land Preservation Act (310)

Regional fisheries personnel received notification of 915 applications for 310 permits from 46 conservation districts throughout the state. Team inspections were held on 620 or 68% of the projects. Conservation districts received an additional 75 applications which were declared non-projects.

For purposes of this report, descriptions of projects were divided into five categories. The number of projects for each category follows: 364 (40%) stream crossings (includes bridges, culverts, fords, pipelines and cables); 196 (21%) irrigation diversions (headgates, pumps and instream structures); 192 (21%) streambank and channel stabilization; 38 (4%) mining; and 124 (14%) miscellaneous (habitat enhancement, ramps, pond development, debris removal and dredging). There were 31 reported complaints or violations which were about evenly distributed between the project descriptions listed above. Applications for permits were denied on 12 projects.

The majority of 310 projects were located in the western and southwestern part of the state. The following table lists 310 activity in the seven fisheries regions for the past three fiscal years:

The number of projects processed in 1991 were an all time high since the 310 program has been in place. Part of this involves an improved reporting system and greater cooperation by conservation districts and regional fishery personnel. Flathead County Conservation District processed the most 310 projects with 98; Gallatin Conservation District was second with 91.

Fiscal 1991 was the first year the Streambank Permitting Contractor Project was in place the entire year. Results of this project are reported under Federal Aid Project F-46-R-4, Job Number VI-D. The increase in projects automatically increased the number of field inspections. Contractors inspected 262 of the 620 projects inspected, or 42%. Work load increased by 56% over FY 1990, so the contractors proved valuable assisting regional personnel.

The Department initiated arbitration with Flathead Conservation District when a permit was issued to Burlington Northern Railroad contrary to our recommendations. Problems with appointing an arbitration panel and delays by Burlington Northern have resulted in no action to resolve the problem. Arbitration proceedings are scheduled for the fall of 1991.

The project leaders attended 6 area conservation district meetings, the MACD State convention and one employee training workshop. The Department, funded two river mechanic training workshops for Beaverhead and Missoula Conservation District. About 100 persons attended the workshops.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that this project be continued. Review and comment concerning projects where environmental evaluation is required by various state and federal statutes should continue. Evaluations of existing aquatic values and possible mitigative measures should be continued where appropriate. Cooperation with other agencies to streamline permit review requirements should continue. River mechanics and other aquatic habitat training workshops should continue to be offered to those involved with the permitting process and stream protection responsibilities.
