Hi there Chris, here is the collection report from the work we conducted in Montana during 1995. The shovelnose sturgeon we collected were returned to the Yellowstone River.

On the other hand, the carp we collected were not returned to the water on Medicine Lake. We did conduct a survey on Medicine Lake this past summer. I'll be forwarding survey results to you and Phil when I finish them up.

I would like to request an application for next year. We are not planning any work specifically in Montana, however when spawning time for the pallids comes around, we may venture across the border to chase down some spawning pallids or shovelnose. All collections we would make would be toward the propagation efforts and all fish would be returned to point of capture. If you could send an application, it would be appreciated.
