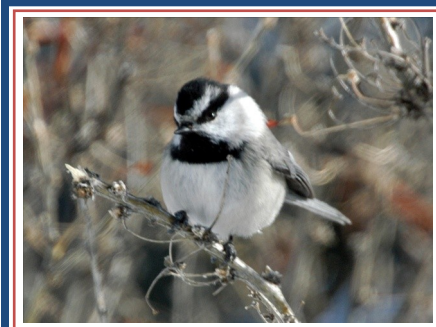

Mount Haggin WMA encompasses 58,188 acres with elevations from 5,200-8,900 feet. It is located in Deer Lodge and Silver Bow counties, approximately 10 miles south of Anaconda at the base of the Anaconda-Pintlar Mountains. Access is along MT Highway 569. Open May 15-Nov 30 north of the Continental Divide and year-round south of the divide.

Fleecer Mountain WMA encompasses 7,394 acres with elevations from 5,440-7,000 feet. It is located in Silver Bow county 20 miles south of Butte off I-15, Take the Divide exit, MT Highway 43. Open May 15-Nov 30.
