



# 2014 ANNUAL VISITATION REPORT

## Montana State Parks

Montana State Parks had a record 2.255 million visits in 2014, which was the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the park system. Statewide visitation is up 3% from 2013 and up 29% for the 10-year period. North Central Region (Great Falls) had the highest overall visitation with over 593,000 visits, and Giant Springs State Park had the highest visitation of all state parks with over 316,000 visits. Peak season visitation was also the highest on record, with over 1.68 million visits, up 3% from 2013.

## 2014 Annual Visitation Report

#### JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2014

The following is a summary of the Montana State Parks 2014 annual visitation, as well as comparisons with 2013 data, and visitation trends.

#### Total statewide visitation is 2,255,038 visits, up 3% from 2013.

5-Year Trend (2010 to 2014): State Parks visitation is up 14%.

10-Year Trend (2005 to 2014): State Parks visitation is up 29%.

### STATEWIDE VISITATION

In 2014, Montana State Parks had the most visits in a single year over the past decade—surpassing the previous record in 2013. The busiest month in 2014 was July with over 516,000 visits, up 9% from 2013 and the highest single month visits over the last five years. On average, there were about 187,000 visits per month, the highest average on record.



Note: In 2014 after an administrative change, Montana State Parks began counting Thompson Chain of Lakes visits into the park system totals. For comparison, 2013 visits are also included.



The top five parks for **annual** visitation in 2014 are:

- 1. Giant Springs State Park (316,483 visits)
- 2. Lake Elmo State Park (163,265 visits)
- 3. Cooney State Park (160,070 visits)
- 4. Spring Meadow Lake State Park (141,727 visits)
- 5. Wayfarers State Park (133,473 visits)

#### **Residency Trends**

## Resident and non-resident visitation is estimated based on a <u>ratio</u> of the total visits, which was established for each park through field sampling.

From <u>2013 to 2014</u>, resident visitation slightly increased from 80% of visits to 81% of visits. As total visitation has been increasing from <u>2010 to 2014</u>, the number of non-resident visits has also been increasing. In 2010, 16% of the visits (316,000 visits) were from non-residents. In 2014, that increased to 19% of visits, or over 428,000 visits—a 36% increase in non-resident visitation from 2010 to 2014. Similarly, resident visitation has also been slowly increasing over the five year period.

#### **VISITATION BY REGION**

The Montana State Parks administrative regions consist of the following:

- Northwest (Kalispell)
- West Central (Missoula)
- Southwest (Bozeman)
- North Central (Great Falls)
- Eastern (Billings)

<u>North Central Region</u> had the highest annual visitation in 2014 with over **593,000 visits**, followed by the Northwest Region with over 566,000 visits. <u>West Central Region</u> had the largest increase in visitation at **31%** over 2013 levels.

<u>North Central Region</u> had the highest visitation by *residents* at 88% and the highest *day use* at 93% of visits. <u>Southwest Region</u> had the highest visitation of *non-residents* at 24%, while <u>West Central</u> <u>Region</u> had the highest *overnight use* at 36% of visits.

#### Peak Season Visitation

Peak season for Montana State Parks is from <u>May to September</u>. The 2014 peak season saw a total of **1,680,121 visits**, <u>up 3%</u> from 2013. Peak season visitation is also <u>up 21%</u> over the five year period from 2010 to 2014, making it the highest visitation from May to September over the last five years. The season's busiest month was July, with over 516,000 visits statewide—the biggest single monthly visitation recorded. <u>Northwest Region</u> (Kalispell) parks had the highest visitation during the summer months with over 455,000 visits, followed by <u>North Central Region</u> (Great Falls) parks with over 395,000 visits.

### **VISITATION BY STATE PARK**

#### Northwest Region (Kalispell)

Wayfarers State Park had the highest visitation in the Northwest Region with 133,472 visits. From 2013 to 2014, Logan State Park had the largest increase in visitation at 30%, followed by Yellow Bay State Park at 18% and Lone Pine State Park at 14%. Thompson Falls State Park decreased in visitation by 7%. In 2014, Thompson Chain of Lakes (TCL) was administratively transferred from the Fisheries Division to the Parks Division. TCL visitation is now included in the overall counts and 2013 data is included for comparison.

#### West Central Region (Missoula)

Frenchtown Pond State Park had the highest visitation in the West Central Region at 60,749 visits. Frenchtown Pond also had the largest increase in visitation at 69% from 2013 to 2014, due to a traffic counter malfunction that staff corrected in 2014. Placid Lake State Park also had a large increase at 59% over 2013 levels, although a malfunction in the visitation counter in 2013 resulted in a lower recorded number. Council Grove State Park decreased in visitation by 13%.

#### Southwest Region (Bozeman)

Cooney State Park had the highest visitation in the Southwest Region at 160,070 visits. From 2013 to 2014, Bannack State Park had the highest increase in visitation, but this follows the park closure Bannack sustained in 2013 due to a flash flood. Prairie Dog Town had the largest decrease in visitation over 2013 levels at 35%.

#### North Central Region (Great Falls)

Giant Springs State Park had the highest visitation in the North Central Region at 316,483 visits. From 2013 to 2014, Tower Rock State Park had the largest increase in visitation at 28%, although Tower Rock decreased in visitation by 24% the previous year. Smith River State Park also increased in visitation by 20% due to a 6-day river closure in July 2013. Ackley Lake had the largest decrease in visitation over 2013 levels at 13%.

#### Eastern Region (Billings)

Lake Elmo State Park had the highest in the Eastern Region at 163,265 visits. Brush Lake State Park increased 27%, followed by Chief Plenty Coups State Park at 22% over 2013 levels. From 2013 to 2014, Makoshika State Park visitation decreased by 30%, however visitation in 2013 was not fully recorded due to summer construction in the area that inadvertently damaged the visitation counter. Pirogue Island decreased in visitation by 20% over 2013 levels.
