# 2019 Mountain Lion Quotas

Lion management units (LMUs), often made up of more than one hunting district, listed in the table below have proposed changes from the 2018 mountain lion quotas in Region 5. All other quotas/subquotas not listed are proposed to be unchanged from 2018 levels.

In their respective areas, the proposals address issues and concerns such as harvest opportunity; lion populations; predation, primarily on mule deer and bighorn sheep; livestock depredations; and human-lion encounters in subdivisions and campgrounds.
