# 1. Summary of significant results.

# **Project Management and Fisheries:**

Sent final review of interagency fisheries data structure to Jim Senkler. He will meet with Bob McFarland to finalize structure from his end. Continued to work on trait look-up table (check off table for limiting factors, management needs, etc.).

Printed out and began checking all streams in fisheries data base where there was a problem in cross-referencing to an EPA reach number. Faxed numerous schematic diagrams of problem areas to Duane Anderson. Printed new EPA tabular file; began to quality check with maps and overlays. Built new cross-reference file after receiving EPA tabular file from Duane Anderson.

Discussed changes and additionals to NRIS 1991 interagency agreement with Jim Stimson. Sent agreement to Bob Lane, FWP lawyer, for review and signatures.

Completed draft Fisheries Division data and information needs assessment and attended meeting in Missoula to discuss. Completed first draft of interagency fisheries input form and instructions for inputting data.

Mailed approximately 100 MRIS USERS EVALUATION forms. Began tabulation of results; obtained 50 percent response rate by end of month.

Wildlife: Asked Region One wildlife biologists to participate in Division's data management "needs assessment" process. Attended Department GIS task group meeting and GIS conference in Missoula. Revised habitat structure for MRIS habitat data base. Began letter to wildlife technical committee which summarizes 1990 and outlines 1991 activities.

Recreation: Contacted all DFWP regions for lists of "sportsmen clubs." Sent 82 letters to clubs/organizations introducing MRIS and requesting lists of members for future use in a recreation survey. Contacted BLM districts/resource areas to discuss their involvement with the update project. Began research for data base. Reviewed Montana Outdoors library. Reviewed books from the county library. Contacted and obtained sources from library data search printout.

NRIS: Completed contract amendment and budget for coming year, delivered to Chris Hunter to obtain FWP signatures. Reviewed MRIS survey forms. Contacted D. Anderson concerning MRIS Tabular and Line Reach files. Met with NRIS GIS personnel to discuss pilot project. Submitting abstract to the American Association of Petroleum Geologist (AAPG) to present a paper or poster on NRIS, MWIS, NHP, GIS, MRIS at the groups Rocky Mountain Section Meeting in Billings, July 28-31, 1991. Brad Shepard requested NRIS to obtain a demo copy of a compact disk fisheries bibliographic data base. I'll alert everyone when it arrives.

Wildlife: Complete update letter to all wildlife committee members. Begin final check of cross-reference between new EPA reach file and wildlife codes. Outline possible pilot/demonstration project for MRIS wildlife update using GIS.

Recreation: Will finish EPA tabular file quality check. Will re-cross recreation data. Will obtain data structure from reviewers and finalize structure.

NRIS: Will examine MRIS line file and outline steps needed to do the update and fill requests.
